**W**e promised last week to show a clearer picture of the concept design for the new Kidsburg. Well, here it is.

When playground organizers presented the sketch and other schematics to Town Council earlier this month, they also broke the news that they expect to build next year, not this one.

Organizers say they'll be using the summer and fall to get approvals from the town and the state Department of Environmental Protection. With no certainty on how long the DEP approval might take, organizer **Deb Huckans**

said, it made more sense to wait until next year to marshal the manpower needed to build Kidsburg 2.0.

Over the winter, **Steve Beattie** of Larson Design Group said the group would also be pricing playground equipment and the other materials needed to build the pirate ships, tree house, swings and other play areas at the new, less flood-prone site.
