Fireworks on the Fourth

The tradition of fireworks on the Fourth of July will continue at Town Park this year, with a few tweaks.

Here's the lowdown on the show's schedule from **Assistant Town Manager Lauren Martz:**

The Catawissa Military Band will begin playing at the bandshell at 8 p.m., and will continue playing until around 9:15.

Then comes a new twist this year. There will be a 10-to-15 minute break between the concert and the fireworks.

That's because the fireworks will be launched from a new location: the soccer fields at the west end of Town Park. That means the best place to see the entire show will be the area of the baseball fields and along Railroad Street. The break should allow people to change their seat location if they would like, Martz said.

There will be a number of food vendors at the park, beginning between 4 and 5 p.m. Twenty cents of every dollar of profits will go toward the effort to rebuild the Kidsburg playground in the park.

The Kidsburg group will also have Pickles the Clown at its stand doing balloon twisting and face painting.

The Press Enterprise has donated \$10,000 toward the cost of the show, which is free and open to all. **Joe and Sheree Martarano** of Bloomsburg have stepped up to cover the cost of the Catawissa Military Band.
